**Saying "NO" is quite easy for me!** "No" is usually the first word that pops out of my mouth after being asked a question. It really aggravates my family. You see, I really need to process a question before I give the answer. To get a more accurate answer, I would prefer they say, "Would you think about this?" then let me give the answer in my time. I have found that when I do this, 75% of the time the answer turns into a "Yes", and they are usually grateful for that!

**Typically, women in ministry say "yes" far more often than men.** Who are the most active in the church? Women. I wonder if at times we have the FOMO Syndrome (Fear Of Missing Out)? My life changed for the better when I grasped the concept of having a **Life Full** rather than a **Full Life**.

*Believing we can have it all, all the time is a myth, a lie, and a joy stealer. What I do believe is that we can have God's best for us. A life full and a full life are two different things.*

**Life Full:** *receiving, room to breathe, trusting, letting go, Spirit led*

**Full life:** *grasping, cramming in, striving, controlling*

God's Word assists us with these two powerful scriptures:

**Galatians 5:25** empowers us with, *"If we live by the Spirit, let us also walk by the Spirit."*

**Romans 8:14** encourages us, *"For all who are led by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God."*

My earthly goal is to have a **"Life Full"** being led by the Holy Spirit. I don't want to be so busy leading a **"Full Life"** that I miss out on what's in front of me. I want to be present and aware of what's happening in the moment.

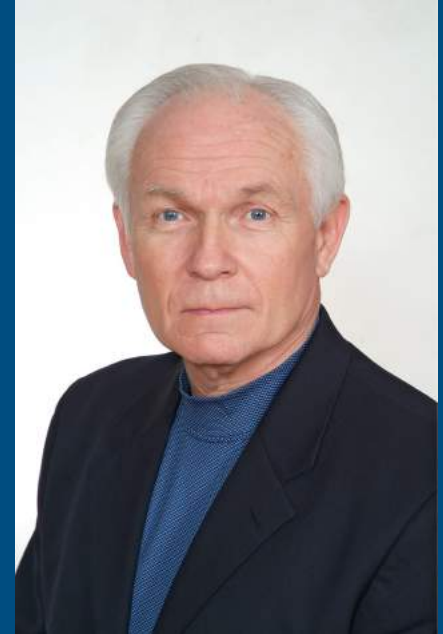
