## PERSPECTIVES FROM THE FIRST LADY Ready, Set, Go #6:

I still remember it like it was yesterday! Many years ago, the Lord gave me a vision (pre-pastoring days). It was late one evening and we had gone out to eat pizza with friends after Sunday night service. Somewhere, in the midst of the conversations, the words being spoken began to fade out and I vividly saw Randell standing behind a large brown pulpit preaching to a congregation full of people. I recognized the place and the pulpit. The vision then faded away and the conversations returned to its normal decibel.

Vision defined is "an experience of seeing someone or something in a dream or trance, or as a supernatural apparition." Has the Lord given you a vision? Has that vision come to fruition? What did you do with the vision? Very seldom do we hear people discussing visions. In Genesis, Joseph had visions/dreams about his family, future and successes. I believe a vision is a special gift from God to help us on our spiritual journey, a little piece of hope to encourage us. Imagine how special it is that the Lord imparted a piece of information just for us.

Here are 4 tips in dealing with visions:

- 1. Acknowledge the vision
- 2. Thank the Lord for providing the vision
- **3.** Share the vision (discreetly)
- **4.** Anticipate its fruition
