Camp Dress Code

- Above all modesty is required at all times.
 - o Modest swimwear is required
 - One piece swimsuits or tankinis that show no stomach
 - Recreation attire is to be modest as well
 - No short shorts or bicycle shorts
 - No shirts that show undergarments
- If you have to ask the answer is probably no!
- No shirts that show the stomach
- Bottom and undergarments must be covered by pants and/or shirt
- Messages on t-shirts must be morally pure or Christian

Heartland Conference Camp Rules

The following expectations are necessary for a safe, enjoyable and effective camp and will be enforced.

- All campers and staff are amenable to the Camp Director(s) and DM Director
- Cabin assignments may not be changed by anyone other than the Camp Director(s) or DM Director and are only done for emergency situations
 - Under no circumstances are campers to change cabins or sleep in cabins other than the one they are assigned to.
- The Golden Rule will serve as a guideline for all our relationships.
- Keep conversation wholesome (no profanity, gossip, or mean-spirited comments)
- Certain areas are off limits except during permitted times (i.e. swimming pool, sanctuary, dining hall, etc.)
- Respect of our facilities and grounds is expected
- ABSOLUTELY NO cell phones

- No electronic devises (iPad, portable games, hand-held electronic devices, etc.) other than cameras
- Modest dress must be worn at all times
- No public display of affection
- Attend all scheduled activities
- No one is permitted to leave camp without the permission of the Camp Director(s) or DM Director
- Only emergency telephone calls are permitted and can only be done through the Camp Director(s) or DM Director

Breaking any of the following rules is cause for an early trip home.

- 1. No girls in guys' cabins and no guys in girls' cabins
- 2. No being out of cabins after hours or being in the wrong cabin
- 3. No pranks allowed
- 4. No fighting
- 5. No vandalism
- 6. No tobacco, drugs, alcohol, e-cigarettes, vapes, edibles etc.
- 7. No weapons of any kind including but not limited to knives and firearms
